Mary Black Minor Care Center bridges the gap between your primary care doctor's office and the hospital emergency department, providing prompt, professional non-emergency care to patients of all ages.

Caring for life's smaller emergencies

The facility offers the same non-emergency services available in your doctor's office, for illnesses or injuries that are not critical or life-threatening. This includes treatment for:

- Colds and flu
- Earaches
- Minor skin lacerations, infections, rashes or burns
- Mild asthma or allergies
- Sinus infections
- Stomachache, diarrhea or vomiting
- Urinary infections

Lab work, x-rays, imaging and ultrasounds are also offered onsite for diagnostic purposes.

A team you know and trust

Mary Black Minor Care is staffed by physicians to care for patients outside of normal doctor's office hours, or for patients who don't have a primary care doctor. You'll have access to the same quality, service and professionalism that you've come to expect from our hospital and physician practices – from the compassionate and experienced team of Mary Black physicians you know and trust.

We accept most insurance plans and can help with physician referrals. Our goal is to serve as an extension – not a replacement – for your regular doctor's care. Mary Black Minor Care should not be used as a substitute for routine preventive care by a primary care doctor who is familiar with your personal medical history.

Know when – and where – to go

Sometimes it's hard to know if your medical need requires the attention of a doctor or the emergency room. Mary Black Minor Care manages non-urgent medical needs and offers the convenience of physician access after office hours and on weekends.

When every minute counts, it's important to choose the right setting for medical treatment.

If you experience any of the following symptoms or feel your condition is serious, go to the emergency room at your nearest hospital immediately:

- Chest pain
- Shortness of breath or severe breathing difficulty
- Difficulty speaking
- Sudden dizziness, loss of coordination or balance
- Severe abdominal pain
- Loss of consciousness
- Numbness or weakness in the face, arm or legs
- Deep cuts or uncontrollable bleeding
- Severe burns
